

Centre for Ethics Undergraduate Fellowships

The University of Toronto Centre for Ethics is pleased to offer one (1) fellowship position to a senior undergraduate student with a serious interest in the study of value theory (including, but not limited to, moral philosophy, law, theories of justice and political theory). The undergraduate fellow will receive a \$1000 scholarship, be provided with carrel space for study at the Centre for Ethics (on the second floor of the Larkin Building), and will be expected to play a leading role in outreach activities at the Centre. The undergraduate fellow is also required to enrol in ETH401H1Y, which combines attendance at Centre for Ethics seminars with an independent research project.

Students are invited to apply for the award directly. Applicants will be selected on the basis of academic background, record of excellence, and promise of future achievement. In order to be eligible, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Be enrolled in a program in the Faculty of Arts and Science, University of Toronto.
2. Be entering fourth year (interpreted here to mean: have completed at least 14 FCE toward your degree by the end of the current term).
3. Have a CGPA of at least 3.7.

A completed application will contain the following:

1. A copy of your most recent transcript from ROSI for all undergraduate work at the University of Toronto.
2. A one-page document describing your intellectual interests in the field of ethics.
3. A copy of a paper you have written in a course related to the subject.
4. The name and email address of an instructor at the University of Toronto who is willing to act as a reference for you.
